
The Jurassic Period began about 200 to 165 million years ago. During this Period, dinosaurs coexisted with mammals. Large Sauropods, like the Brachiosaurus thrived in this period. Brachiosaurus were heavy, long-necked, herbivores that walked on four legs.

The <u>Triassic Period</u> dates back to 251 to 200 million years ago. Many dinosaurs in this period were small carnivores. They had hollow bones, walked on their hind legs, and were quick. Herrerasaurus was a dangerous predator in the Triassic Period.

The Cretaceous Period
dates from 145 to 65 million
years ago. Herbivores, such
as Triceratops and
Ankylosaurs, lived in this
period. They lived in herds
to protect themselves from
carnivores like the
Velociraptor. During the
Cretaceous Period, insects
started to appear and it was
during this period that
dinosaurs became extinct.


